General information

Wristbands

All drivers and mechanics present at Bellahøj Park for CHGP 2022 MUST wear a valid wristband.

Extra wristbands can be purchased at the CPHG Race Office. Persons without valid wristbands will be expelled from the area. Team clothing is not valid for access to the area.

Similar to all other guests at CHGP 2022, drivers and mechanics must comply with CHGP's regulations. Please note that you are not allowed to bring your pets to the event.

Food

In case a team member wants to bring food from outside the area, the person MUST bring a valid food voucher, which you will receive in the Drivers' Envelope upon arrival. This voucher is needed to enter the area with food from outside, in order to let the volunteers at the entrances know that you are allowed to bring food for your team. Please be nice and patient towards the volunteers at the entrance, as they are just doing their job and controlling wristbands and valid vouchers.

Drivers' Meeting

A drivers' Meeting will this year be held online as a pre-recorded meeting that all drivers are obligated to participate at and watch throughout. In addition, question time will be held on Friday 5 August at 14-15 in Grøndal Multicenter at the Press Center.

Entry guide

When participating in the CHGP 2022 please arrive at Bellahøj Park either Thursday, August 4th between 9.00 and 22.00 or Friday, August 5th between 8.00 and 16.00.

If you arrive later than 16.00 Friday afternoon, however, you will have to expect to wait as the entry will be closed due to test driving on the track between 17.00 and 22.00.

GPS-Guide: Enter "Motorring 3 – Exit 23 Jyllingevej" on your GPS.

From here you take Jyllingevej, which will be crossing Bellahøjvej leading you straight to Entry West "INDGANG VEST" from where you can enter the area.

When you arrive at INDGANG VEST you will be greeted by our arrival-team who will be ready to assist you and guide you around the area.

In case of heavy rain please be patient upon arrival.

Everybody is interested in a good flow at the entrance. We would like to welcome all our participants as fast and smoothly as possible. However, due to the experience from the past years, we have to respect the weather and the circumstances created by the weather.

We therefore hope that you will be patient upon arrival.

License

A Danish or international license with a starting permit is mandatory for all participants at Copenhagen Historic Grand Prix 2022.

Paddock placement, Race Office and Technical Control

When you arrive at CHGP please head to the Paddock Office. Tim Nellemann will assign you your space in the paddock. This will take place either Thursday, August 4th between 9.00 and 20.00 or Friday, August 5th between 08.00 and 16.00.

After you have been assigned your space in the paddock, please consult the Race Office which will be open on Thursday between 15.00 and 20.00 and Friday between 8.00 and 20.00. The Race Office is located in area L3, Main Street. At the Race Office, your license will be validated, and you will receive the Drivers' Envelope containing driver registration and further information.

Race Office

The race office is located in area L3 by the main street (see appendix), and will be open as follows:

Thursday, August 5th between 16:00 and 20:00

Friday, August 6th between 08:00 and 20:00

Saturday, August 7th between 08:00 and 19:00

Sunday, August 8th between 08:00 and 19:00

When your license has been validated, please see Technical Control who will review and approve your vehicle. The Technical Control can be located in the paddock Thursday, August 4th between 16:00-20:00 and Friday, August 5th between 8:00-20:00. If the car is approved, Technical Control will sign the driver registration and you will receive a label of approval, signifying that you are ready to race.

Præmiering

As something new this year (2022), there will be division trophies for all divisions in classes 65, 71, 90, YTCC and Legend according to Danish Master regulations 2.2.

After constructive communication with several class representatives, division trophies have been requested, which we've worked on to coordinate with our supplier. This has now succeeded, and we are therefore pleased to be able to introduce this to this year's Grand Prix in the first weekend of August.

The trophies are ordered according to regulation 2.2 in the Danish Masters and is registered at the end of race entry on 15 July 2022.

Clearance in case of accidents on track

Be aware, in case of accidents on the track, the team in charge of clearing the track is only instructed to move vehicles away from the track and to the nearest unloading area. The clearance team is not instructed to deliver vehicles to paddock.

Area rules



ONLY access with valid wristband

Exchange of ticket to wristband must be made at ticket booth



Opening hours:

Friday 5pm - 22pm

Saturday and Sunday 8 am – 6 pm



Children:

Children under the age of 12, have free access to the area, as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid entry ticket. Free tickets can be picked up at the ticket booth, when accompanied by an adult. If children (from age of 5) wish to get a seat on the grand stands, they need to purchase an additional ticket.



Handicap helpers:

Do you need the assistance of a handicap helper while at the area? Your helper can get a free ticket at the ticket booth when presenting their official and valid helper ID. The helper must be accompanied by the handicapped person.



Food & Drinks:

Food and drinks may not be brought from outside the event area. It is permitted to bring water for own consumption in plastic containers.



Security:

Our security personnel has the highest authority in the area. You must follow the instructions given by them. If these are not complied with, the personnel may evict you without warning. No reimbursement will be possible.



Access to CHGP and Bellahøj Camping:

Guests at Bellahøj Camping **MUST** have valid CHGP bracelets.

Bracelets can be purchased from the ticket booths located at all entrances. No refunds.

People without valid CHGP bracelets will be expelled from the area.



Bicycles:

Bicycles can only be brought into the area through Entry West at Bellahøjvej during the hours of 18.00 – 07.00. Bicycles are not allowed on the bridges.



Animals (including dogs):

NO ANIMALS are allowed at the Copenhagen Historic Grand Prix. However, fully trained and registered driver- and assistance dogs are welcome. Please contact our information at tel. 86 51 99 29 so preparations can be clarified before your arrival. It is, however, not recommended that the animals are exposed to loud sounds from our motorsport activities. Driver- and assistance dogs are not allowed in the paddock, by garages or in the pit. Please do not leave dogs locked in cars in parking lots. Dogs must, at all times, be on a leash.



Miscellaneous:

Collection of bottles and cans is strictly prohibited. Theft, vandalism, inappropriate and abusive behavior will be reported to the police and will result in immediate dismissal.



Regarding the use of open flames, the guideline of CHGP and the fire department must be followed. We have zero tolerance for euphoricants of any kind. We will report any usage or possession of euphoricants.
